**"The Innes Nota Bene Award"** is named for the first recipients in 2015 - Duncan and Monica Innes of Kelowna, two incredibly faithful long-time supporters. In 2016, Donna Schellenberg of Penticton was honored for her significant contributions.

In 2018 the board of directors is opening up the nomination process to our community so that our supporters can participate in the OSO's recognition of people who have been important to the organization. **The OSO wants to hear from across the region.** You may know "just the right person" who in your mind has been instrumental in keeping the OSO relevant in our community.

By definition, support is not limited to the making of financial contributions. For example, the nominee could have been a volunteer or an advocate in the community.

All nominations will be considered by a committee of 5 people - the OSO's music director, general manager and one community volunteer representing each of Vernon, Kelowna and Penticton.

The award will be presented on stage at the final Masterworks concert in May.
