National auditions are open to Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents of Canada only.

The Collective Agreement provides for the following wages and conditions for the 2022-2023 season.

- Services: minimum 56
- Benefits: Group Benefit Plan + 14% CFM – Musicians’ Pension Fund of Canada contribution
- Compensation - Principal: \$153.57 per service + \$37.79 per service expense payment + 4% vacation pay
- Musicians living outside the Okanagan Valley receive a travel allowance based on city of residence in concert weeks plus shared hotel accommodation.

The Core musicians of the Okanagan Symphony Orchestra are members of the Canadian Federation of Musicians.
