CELEBRATION 1: MESSIAH December 20, 21 & 22, 2024 DAVID FALLIS, GUEST CONDUCTOR

For the first time since the pandemic, Handel's timeless oratorio, Messiah, returns to our stages. Along with the voices of the OSO Chorus and four stellar soloists (soprano Noémi Kiss, mezzo-soprano Simran Claire, tenor Jeremy Scinocca, baritone Gregory Dahl), the OSO's performance of this holiday tradition will fill your heart and soul with a symphony of emotions.

CELEBRATION 2 March 7 & 8, 2025 DANIEL LAPP, FIDDLE & TRUMPET JEFF FARAGHER, GUEST CONDUCTOR

Daniel Lapp and the OSO fiddle and dance their way through a program of hornpipes, jigs, waltzes and everything in between that celebrates folk music at its best. Daniel is steeped in the old-time dancing fiddle tradition and is an accomplished trumpeter to boot. He will astound you with his innovative approach to music.

CELEBRATION 3 May 9 & 10, 2025 & the OSYO SIDE-BY-SIDE LARA ST. JOHN, VIOLIN KELLY LIN, GUEST CONDUCTOR*

Violinist Lara St. John has been described as 'volcanic,' a 'phenomenon,' a 'maverick,' and a 'high-powered soloist.' Her fiery interpretation of Astor Piazzolla's The Four Seasons of Buenos Aires, along with the OSYO Side-by-Side performance of José Pablo Moncayo's Huapango, will plunge you into the sensual universe of Latin music. *Guest conductor Kelly Lin is a Fellow in Tapestry Opera's Women in Musical Leadership program.
