Each chair has a particular role and hierarchy, often reflecting the musician's experiences and responsibilities. They include the Concertmaster, Assistant Concertmaster, Principal, and Section Players.

### What is the commitment?

Chair Sponsorships range in price from \$750 to \$3000 per year for a three-year term. They provide a certain cachet, with recognition on both our website and in our house programs. In addition, you have the satisfaction of that special connection with a member of the orchestra.
