National auditions are open to Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents of Canada only.

The Okanagan Symphony Orchestra is a per service orchestra with a core of 20 musicians.

The Collective Agreement provides for the following wages and conditions for the 2026-2027 season.

- Services: minimum 56
- Benefits: Group Benefit Plan + 14% CFM – Musicians' Pension Fund of Canada contribution
- Compensation - Principal: \$166.22 per service + 4% vacation pay + \$40.88 per service expense payment.
- Musicians living outside the Okanagan Valley receive a travel allowance for concert weeks based on city of residence plus shared hotel accommodation.

The Core musicians of the Okanagan Symphony Orchestra are members of the Canadian Federation of Musicians.
